



- **Meets APA Product Specification for E-720 G5 grade for formaldehyde emissions**
- **Meets the E<sub>0</sub> level of AS/NZS 4357: Part 4, LVL Formaldehyde Emissions**
- **Meets the JAS F☆☆☆☆ Formaldehyde limits of the JAS Standard for LVL**
